	 The Rugby Community Wellbeing Hub service is based at the BPC. Opening hours are: 9:30am to 4:30pm Monday to Friday, except 1:00pm - 4:30pm on Wednesdays. This is a free information, advice & signposting service for adults with learning disabilities.
	On Christmas day each year we provide a free Christmas Day Event including a three course meal for members of the community who would otherwise be alone. We will be taking names for Christmas 2017 from September onwards.
