A brief introduction and history of your centre/venue	The building has been on the site at Rugby United Reformed Church, 40 Hillmorton Road, Rugby, CV22 5AD for over 60 years and has been home to Whitehall Pre-school, Girl Guides, Brownies, Rainbows, Scouts, Cubs & Beavers.
Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight	It is now home to Street Cats Dance group and Chinese Education Society. The building is used each week by about 350 people of all ages and ethnic origins & other multigenerational organisations.
Volunteering opportunities currently available	Plans are at a late stage of development to bring the building up to 21 st Century modern standards and we are earnestly fundraising to raise £350,00 to demolish the old building and rebuild the replacement late 2017/early 2018.
