| A brief introduction and history of your centre/venue | The Bulkington Village Centre Project was established in 1996 with the objective of using the site of the former Bulkington First School to create a multi-function community facility. A group of local unpaid volunteers formed a charitable company and successfully applied for funding support from WCC, NBBC and the National Lottery. The site now houses a Doctors Surgery, NHS Clinic, Day Nursery, pre-school provision and a Children's Centre. In addition we have 7 rooms are available for accommodating community activities. The main objectives of BVC are that the Centre should be financially self-supporting and that all operating profits should be ploughed back into the Centre to benefit the local community. |
| Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight | The Centre has 7 various sized rooms for hire by the community or local businesses/organisations. Two rooms are ideal for larger events, able to accommodate a bouncy castle or we have a lovely enclosed garden area. Most rooms are fitted with integral multimedia systems for your use. We also have an IT suite fitted with laptops & desktop computers enabling us to hold many computer based courses. |
