A brief introduction and history of your centre/venue	The Newtown Centre is a former Womens Royal Voluntary Service and Nuneaton & Bedworth Borough Council venue, that WCAVA moved into in January 2017. Based in the centre of Nuneaton, it serves as a base for WCAVA and Talent Match activities, as well as being a thriving community centre, with activities taking place morning to evening, Monday-Saturday. Every Wednesday, the centre is used as a hub for the Healthy Living Network to host a range of activities, included craft, seated exercise, honesty shop and the People’s Pantry. It has been very successful for a number of years, and there are exciting plans afoot to increase the scope of the activities on offer.
Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight	Newtown is also home the world champion Chater Dance Academy, who meet at the centre 4 days a week. Other activities include weekly meetings of Nuneaton Stroke Club, Drop In Club for people with mental health issues, as well as being used as an outreach venue for organisations such as RoSA, Shaw Trust and other health and social care providers.
