We have a main room - all on one level - with a kitchen and a toilet that is disabled friendly with a baby changing mat, potty and step for young children to be able to wash their hands. There is an enclosed garden at the rear of the building.
Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight	The groups that currently use us are - Ridge Lane Youth Club (ages 6 to 13 years), the Women's Institute and Barnardos. The Community Room is also available for children's birthday parties, family parties, social occasions, sales, including table top sales, etc. Alcohol is not allowed on the premises.
Volunteering opportunities currently available	Volunteers - If anyone was willing to volunteer their services they would have to have current certification to be able to work with children or vulnerable adults.
