A brief introduction and history of your centre/venue	The original Studley Village Hall was built in the early 1960s and served the local community. In June 2003 the new Village Hall was officially opened to cater for a wide range of functions, from small meetings to wedding receptions, stage productions & corporate events. It is a modern venue with many rooms and excellent facilities. The hall can offer raised seating, stage lighting, PA facilities, dressing rooms, bar services and seating for approximately 120 people.
	The hall is a focal point in Studley and caters for young and old. The facilities are well used by local residents for a range of services and activities, as well as providing a meeting point, a place to chat over a coffee and meet people. It is very much the heart of Studley.
Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight	Studley Village Hall offers a vast range of activities including line dancing, indoor bowls, Slimming World, Weight Watchers, Spiritual groups, Kick boxing, Yoga, Pilates, dance classes, WI, Studley Women's Country Club and singing groups - to name

but a few. Studley Village Hall is regularly used for theatre productions, music evenings, and local Brownies and Guide groups, as well as annual events such as awards evenings. The hall is also home to the Studley Parish Council office, Library, Citizens Advice, Counselling facilities and the Coffee Break Café.
