A brief introduction and history of your centre/venue	The Jubilee Centre is a Council owned building, run by a small Management Group which consists of councillors and volunteers, whose aim is to provide cost effective community facilities for all residents and associations within the town.
Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight	The Centre is located adjacent to the Jubilee Fields, the all-weather Multi Use Game Area and the town's two Primary schools. In addition to a large community hall (Hertford Room), it also houses the Depot, a purpose built room to accommodate Youth facilities. Both rooms are of a high specification and serviced by their own facilities. Currently, the Centre is currently home to the Alcester Male Voice Choir, the Alcester Dementia Café, Slimming World, Tae
	Kwon Do, Youth Club, U3A, Cinema Club and the Alcester Health and Well Being Board. It is also available to hire for private parties and events.
Volunteering opportunities currently available	Alcester is lucky to have a large volunteer base and most of the user groups at the centre are run by or supported by those volunteers. However, more volunteers are always welcome!
