<b>Services and activities at your centre you would like to highlight</b>	The centre is used by up to 50 groups, with a wide range of activities catering for young and old - from 'Little Angels' pre schoolers and their carers, youth, exercise classes, business and training meetings, dances, art groups and a variety of interest groups for older people. The centre also hosts an informal Sunday "Connections" service, every Sunday at 10.15, to which all are welcome.  There are also spaces in the schedule for parties and regular or occasional events, morning, afternoon or evenings.
