

Warwickshire Integrated Neighbourhood Teams:

June 2026 Update



We are pleased to confirm that the Warwickshire Integrated Neighbourhood Team (INT) footprints have now been approved, marking a key milestone in the development of neighbourhood health across Warwickshire.

INTs will bring together partners from health, social care, local government, and the voluntary and community sector to deliver more joined-up, preventative care for local populations, improving outcomes through better use of collective resources and local insight.

Warwickshire INT Footprints Confirmed

The Warwickshire model comprises eight INTs, across three Places. The footprints have been developed through a co-produced process with system partners, informed by population need, service mapping, local insight and natural communities.

With the footprint design now agreed, the programme has moved into the mobilisation and delivery phase. Mobilisation workshops commenced in June, bringing partners together to develop local operating models, agree priority pathways and identify enablers required for delivery, including workforce, digital, estates, data, leadership and community engagement.



Neighbourhood Fund Update

The Care Collaborative Forum has approved the principles, process and priorities for the Neighbourhood Fund for 2026/27. The fund will focus on two key priorities:

1. Mobilising and delivering INTs to provide proactive, personalised and coordinated care for priority cohorts, with a focus on reducing non-elective activity.
2. Developing an enhanced Warwickshire-wide Single Point of Access model to support people in crisis or at risk of escalation to be managed safely in the community, reducing avoidable hospital admission.

To maintain momentum, proposals and any associated subcontracting arrangements should be developed during June for approval by the Care Collaborative Committee in July. We will work with leads across existing workstreams to ensure proposals are aligned to agreed priorities and progressed through the appropriate governance routes. This represents an important opportunity to strengthen partnership working, accelerate neighbourhood-based models of care and deliver improved outcomes for local people and communities.
